C. Rounding Numbers

Rounded numbers tell about how many or how much but are not exact.

Round to nearest 10

When we round a number to nearest 10, we use the nearest multiple of 10. Example

1. 63 is closer to 60
So, 63 rounds to 60
2. 65 is a midway number
It is rounded to next higher number
So, 65 is rounded to 70.

Round to the nearest 10
