In connection with the subject & reference captioned above, the matter was got verified from SSP Traffic City Srinagar which reveals as under:-

- 1. The total area of the proposed site is 201465 Sqfts.
- 2. The built-up area is 59625 Sqfts.
- 3. The distance of the site from the main road is 400 Mtrs.
- 4. The Playground is available and its area is **74520 Sqfts.**
- 5. The Prayer ground is available and its area is 53965 Sqfts.
- 6. The Parking space is available and its area is 10336 Sqfts.
- 7. 39 vehicles are owned/hired by the school authorities for transportation of students.
- 8. The school was established in the Year 2014.
- 9. The school is running from Nursery to 12th Class.
- 10. Total strength of the students enrolled in the school is 1960.

Therefore, as recommended by SSP Traffic City Srinagar, this office has no objection to the functioning of the above-mentioned School from traffic point of view, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. There should be no violation of Motor Vehicle Act.
- 2. School administration should abide by the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding safety of students
- 3. This NOC is limited to the present infrastructure and in case School administration wants to upgrade its present strength/ infrastructure, it should apply for fresh NOC.
- 4. The school authority shall not use main/link road for parking. The vehicles of the school should be parked in already earmarked parking space available within the school premises.
- 5. The school authority shall frame a well defined time interval during the arrival and departure of the school vehicles so as to not cause congestion on the link road during the entry/exit of the school vehicles in the morning as well as in the afternoon during school closure time.
- 6. The school authority will take notice of residential area which is thickly populated are not facing any sort of inconvenience by the movement of school transport fleet.
- 7. The school authority shall ensure that the boarding and de-boarding of students is done inside the school premises to avoid unnecessary congestion on the road.

8. In case of deviation in any of the above-mentioned condition at any later stage, NOC

shall be treated as cancelled.
