Doon School Srinagar hosted an enriching online student exchange program with students of Norway.

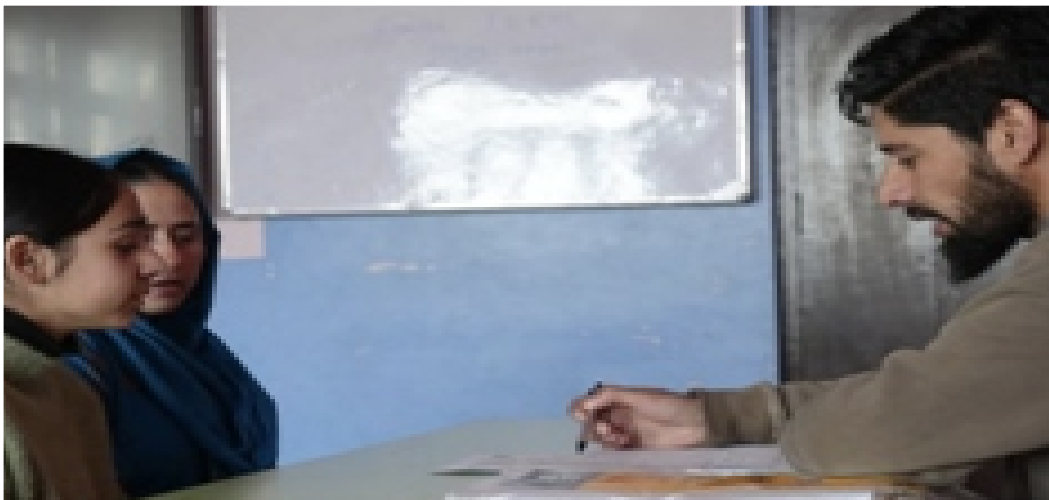

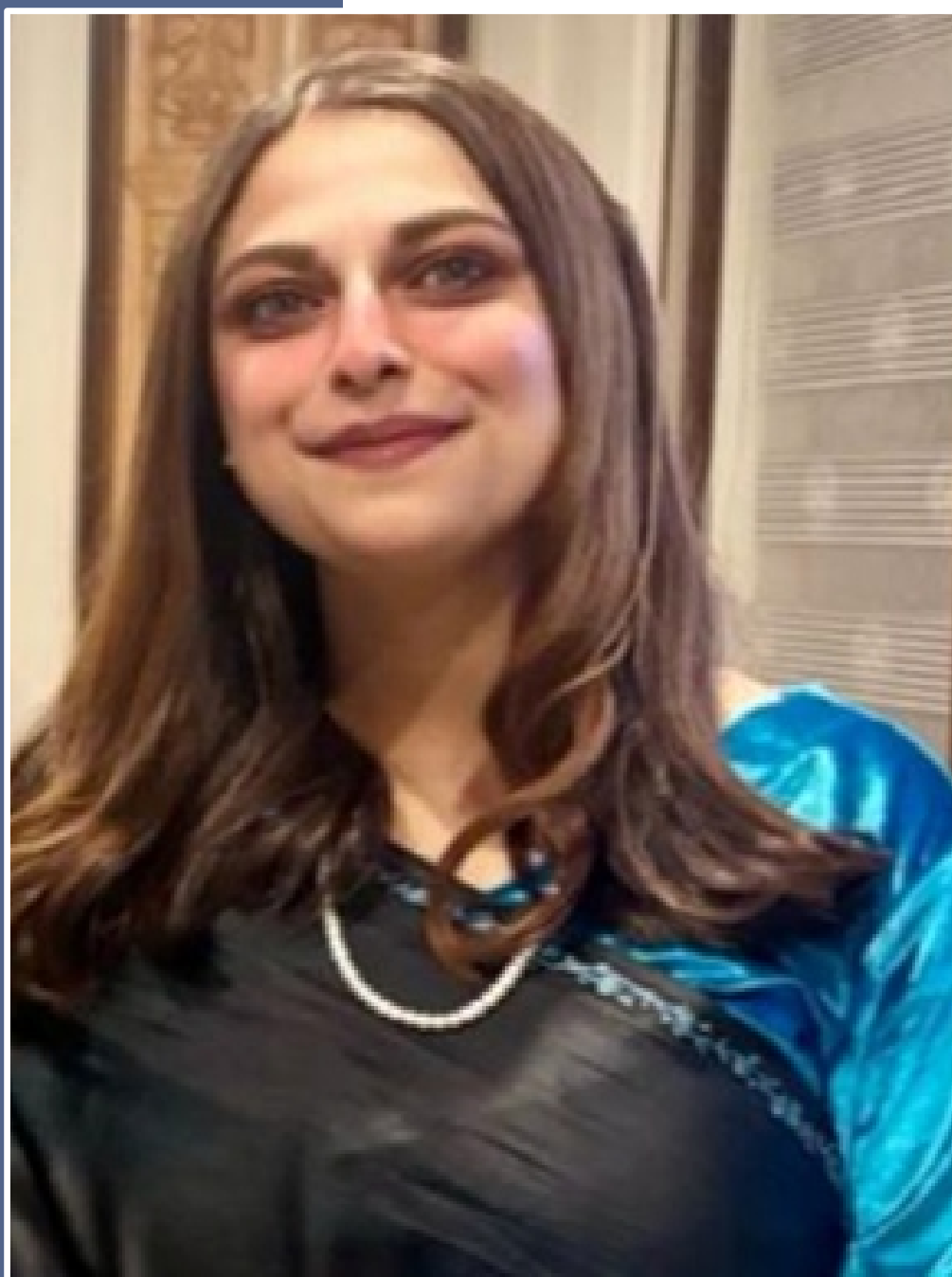
